

## CoMobility - Newsletter 17

- *Save the Date! Registration is open!* The fourth edition of the 'Workshops for Local Governments' will take place on 14 September 2023 in Kraków. The meeting is planned as a hybrid, with stationary participants from Kraków and the surrounding area and online participants from all over Poland. - As suggested by experts, we are working on measures for the social impact of the project. We reflect on how to popularise the results in a non-scientific environment. In particular, the results of new prototypes of interventions in public spaces.
- [A scooter monument was unveiled](#) has been unveiled at the school in Targówek. It is a public space intervention to remind children and parents of the importance of active forms of mobility, as well as to teach them how to move safely around the city.
- In June, [a series of meetings in the 'Round Table' form](#) where students and officials took part in urban laboratories. It was an opportunity to share knowledge and experiences gained from co-designing and implementing interventions in the project school setting.
- We have completed the collection of the latest round of data on the transport preferences of Warsaw residents. This time, the experimental part is about shared mobility. More information [here](#). Thus, in June, we completed all the survey research planned for the CoMobility project.
- June and July are the months in which most summer science conferences take place. Our team performed, among others, at the [X Transdisciplinary Symposium on Qualitative Research in Ustka 'Research for a Better World.'](#)
- The CoMobility project has been nominated in the ['Polish Prize for Intelligent Development'](#) competition. The results will be announced during the [Smart Growth Forum 2023](#) in Uniejów in October 2023. We are keeping our fingers crossed for the success of our team!
- Plans for the next few months:
  - Less-numerous teams are working on further scientific publications presenting the project's research findings.
  - We have started work to make the data and results of the project publicly available. The data is currently being anonymised. A wider release is planned for spring 2024.
  - On 14-15 September 2023, a meeting of the entire consortium will be held in Kraków.
  - During the annual conference of the Faculty of Economics at the University of Warsaw, 28-29 September 2023, a session summarising some of the research conducted by the

UW team is planned. We will present papers on 'Social Barriers to Sustainable Transition: The Case of Mobility Systems In Central Europe,' 'Access To Education And Clean Air: Public Policies in Warsaw Primary Schooling,' 'Exploring Transportation Preferences In Warsaw To Motivate Public Transport.'

- Together with the City Hall, we have started preparations for the final conference of the CoMobility project, which will take place in Warsaw in spring 2024.
